PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to or near water. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to fish in water adjacent to treated areas. See Directions for Use for additional precautions and requirements.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

USE RESTRICTIONS

For outdoor use only.

Do not allow the product to enter any indoor or outdoor drains.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift.

Except for protected handlers applying outdoors as a surface, space or fogging spray, do not enter or allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.

Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until sprays have dispersed.

Do not wet plants or articles to point of runoff or drip.

Do not use treated article until spray has dried.

Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application.

Remove or cover all dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces or wash them before use. Do not use on edible crops.

All outdoor spray applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

1. Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, lawn, turf, and other vegetation;
2. Perimeter band treatments of 7 feet wide or less from the base of a man-made structure to pervious surfaces (e.g., soil, mulch, or lawn);
3. Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure;
4. Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch;
5. Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.), up to 2 feet above ground level;
6. Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, lawn, turf, mulch or other vegetation, only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches, storm drains, gutters, or surface waters.

Spot Treatment Guidance Statement: Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2 ft by 1 ft or 4 ft by 0.5 ft).

Buffer from Water Statement: For soil or foliar applications, do not apply by ground within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds.

Water Protection Statements: Do not spray the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly to sewers or storm drains, or to any area like a drain or gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application. Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment. Do not apply or irrigate to the point of runoff.



Rain-Related Statements: Do not make applications during rain. Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours). Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application.

Crack-and-Crevice Treatments: Treat surfaces to ensure thorough coverage but avoid runoff. To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants.

Do not apply when the wind speed is greater than 15 mph.

To apply at the maximum rate, spray for about 25 seconds to cover a space of 100 sq ft (10' X 10').

FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Hold container upright and spray.

Starbar® EZ™ Outdoor Fogger works by contact – contact as many insects as possible with the spray.

OUTDOORS: Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift. Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

Repeat treatments to infested areas as necessary at intervals of 14 days or greater.

Pests on Outside Surfaces of Buildings: For control of building infestation due to Ants, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes, and Sowbugs (Pillbugs). Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance, up to a height of 2 feet. Hold can 2 to 3 feet from surface to be treated and spray to slightly moisten surface. Apply as a residual spray to outside surface of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages and refuse dumps.

FLYING INSECTS: Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths, Bees, Hornets and Yellow Jackets. Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans and compost piles.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Mole Crickets, Centipedes, and Silverfish. Hold can 2 to 3 feet from surface to be treated and spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Spray to slightly moisten the surface. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant trails and hills. Ants, Ticks, Crickets, Fleas and Earwigs: Apply thoroughly to infestations in bushes, grass or weeds.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in a cool, dry area away from children.

Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for local disposal options. Do not dispose of down-the-drain or sewer.
